ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2025-2026

Dear Members,

It is a moment of pride for me to welcome you to the Annual General Body Meeting of our Club. On this occasion, I would like to express my heartfelt gratitude to all members for their support throughout the years 2024-2025 and 2025-2026. Your continued trust in the Management, presence, and involvement in the various activities of the Club gave me immense strength to make the Club's 160th and 161st years memorable.

I thank the President, Vice-President, Joint Secretary, Treasurer, all members of the Managing Committee/Board, and the co-opted members for the support extended to me. On many occasions during the year, I sought advice from senior members and legal luminaries on matters relating to the Club. Several members who were not on the Committee also helped me in serving the Club, and I offer them my special thanks. I am confident that future Managements will continue to pursue the Club's improvement. If, unknowingly, I have displeased anyone, I sincerely apologise.

In the interest of the Club and its members, the practice of cashless clubbing was implemented strictly, and its benefits are already evident. Computerisation and systems integration were undertaken to improve efficiency and transparency. A wide range of entertainment programmes, Mega Housie events, and health check-up camps with expert consultations were organised to promote the health and well-being of members and their families all round development activities. A monthly staff award was introduced to boost staff morale and encourage excellence in service. All events and entertainment programmes gave due priority to our traditions while taking members' preferences into account. We also started an archive to preserve the old memories and heritage of our Club and to publish a monograph on it. Our efforts focused on improving Club services, preventing pilferage, and providing members with an enjoyable clubbing experience.

The Cuttack Club implemented a Minimum User Fee of Rs.500 per month for all categories of members with effect from January 2026. However, outstation members, honorary members, and members above 70 years of age are exempt. The Club generated a surplus of approximately Rs. 11,00,000 during the first quarter, from January to March 2026 & Rs.10,25,869 during the second quarter, from April to June 2026.
